



## Professional Development Unit (PDU) Calculation for PMPs

PMI Global Congresses present a unique opportunity for certified PMPs to earn a significant amount of PDUs toward maintenance of their credential.

Typically, one PDU is earned for every one hour spent in a planned, structured learning experience or activity. Fractions of PDUs may be reported in 0.25 increments following one full hour.

This worksheet lists all activities that qualify for PDUs at PMI Global Congress 2007 – North America (6-9 October) as well as those at the PMI Leadership Institute Meeting (4-6 October).

Mark your attendance at the activities on this worksheet and claim the total PDUs on a Continuing Certification Requirements (CCR) Activity Reporting Form. This PDU Worksheet should NOT be included when submitting the claim. However, it must be kept in your personal records for verification of attendance if you are audited.
